

Coastal Medical is now Brown Health Medical Group Primary Care


- 160 clinicians caring for 152,000 patients at 21 locations

 - Proactive vs. Reactive
- Moved to Value-Based Care in 2012
- Coastal Medical joined Lifespan in 2021
- 60% of patients covered under primary care capitation
