## Surest copays simplify the member experience and minimize unexpected bills

# The Surest plan is a better benefit

Reduces confusion with <u>no deductible</u> and no coinsurance—only copays.

- Lower copays are assigned to providers
   evaluated as high value based on effectiveness
   and cost efficiency data
- Copays include the services delivered in that visit/admission, helping eliminate unexpected bills
- There is <u>no single</u> Surest plan copay that would cause a member to immediately reach their out-of-pocket maximum. Only 1% of members hit their OOPM.<sup>1</sup>
- Members can search ahead of time to know what they will pay
